Jeffrey Collé of Estates by Jeffrey Collé has been in the business for nearly 35 years. He has renovated Hamptons landmarks like the former Gardiner family estate (Maidstone Hall) and built new attractions such as Beechnut Hill Farm. Collé recently took a hiatus from building to focus on

sustainable agriculture, and it shows in his designs. On a piece of land where most would fit 18 homes, he plans to build only five.
